- **TIME:** The event will run from 12 – 3pm (Registration at 11 games start promptly at 12).
  
- **FEES**

Fees for this event will be via donation. Minimum \$5.00 entry fee but feel free to donate more for a worthy cause! Pledges would be greatly encouraged and appreciated. Highest pledges for the date will receive a prize!! Bring receipt of payment to one of these organizations as proof of donation to play in the tournament. Payment on day of will be made either by cash, or if paying by cheque, please make payable to Rockwood Naturopathic Clinic and the clinic will then distribute the donations evenly to both organizations.
  
- **RULES**

The object of the game is to eliminate all opposing players by getting them "OUT". This may be done by:

  1. Hitting an opposing player with a thrown ball below the shoulders. Note: If a player ducks, and this is clearly the cause for the player being hit above the shoulders, the player is out and the throw is legal.
  2. Catching a ball thrown by your opponent before it touches the ground.
  3. Causing an opponent to drop a live ball as a result of contact by another thrown live ball. (Usually occurs when a ball is being used to block a thrown ball.
  4. An opposing player stepping out of bounds. (To avoid getting hit and not because he or she is retrieving a ball - in which case you have 5 seconds to retrieve a ball, and come immediately back into the playing field.)

Game begins by placing the dodgeballs along the center line. Players then take a position behind their end line. Following a signal by the official, teams may approach the centerline to retrieve the balls. This signal officially starts the contest.

This game will be mostly an honour system, though there will be monitors as well.

- **Prizes**
